

Vanavarayar Institute of Agriculture (VIA) was **founded in the year 2007 by Padma Bhusan Arutchelvar Dr. N. Mahalingam**whose commitment for agricultural and rural development is
well known. His vision was to deliver quality education to the
rural youths and lay a strong foundation for modernizing
agricultural sector by adopting sustainable farming practices,
innovative cost effective technologies, responsible utilization of
natural resources and improving the livelihood of farmers and
recognizing their contribution to the nation.

This institution functions under "Nachimuthu Industrial Association (NIA)" (Registration No. 3432 of 1956), a trust established in 1956 to fulfil his father Shri. P. Nachimuthu Gounder' vision of providing education to aspiring rural youth. Under the guidance of the governing council, VIA has taken consistent efforts to fulfil the vision of the founder by empowering youth through education and entrepreneurship development programmes.

With the approval of Govt. of Tamil Nadu, VIA offers four year B.Sc. (Hons) Agriculture programme with the intake of 200 students per year. The institution has permanent affiliation with Tamil Nadu Agricultural University (TNAU), Coimbatore. VIA is accredited by Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), New Delhi for a period of five years i.e., from 17.08.2021 to 16.08.2026 vide F. No. 1/40/2018-EQR.Edn. dt.03.09.2021. VIA has also obtained 2f status from University Grants Commission (UGC), New Delhi.
